



STOP! FBI Raids on Antiwar Activists!

On Friday September 24th, the FBI raided eight homes and offices of antiwar and social justice activists in Chicago and Minneapolis. The FBI agents seized books, music CD's, photographs, computers, cell phones, check books, papers, cameras and every other items that could contain information and saved data. The FBI also handed subpoenas to testify before a federal grand jury to fourteen activists in Illinois, Minnesota, and Michigan. These activists are involved in many groups, including the Twin Cities Anti-War Committee, the Palestine Solidarity Group, the Columbia Action Network, Students for a Democratic Society, and the Freedom Road Socialist Organization.

This undemocratic and suppressive action against antiwar and peace activists has been denounced and condemned by numerous antiwar and social justice organizations in the United States.

This action is part of a week of action across the US and beyond, to stop the FBI and Grand Jury repression, called by the Committee to Stop FBI Repression for the week of Nov. 29th to Dec. 3rd.
