STOP FBI RAIDS ON ANTI-WAR ACTIVISTS!

On Friday September 24th, the FBI raided eight homes and offices of antiwar and social justice activists in Chicago and Minneapolis. The FBI agents seized books, music CD's, photographs, computers, cell phones, check books, papers, cameras and every other items that could contain information and saved data. The FBI also handed subpoenas to testify before a federal grand jury to activists in Illinois, Minnesota, and Michigan. These activists are involved in many groups, including the Twin Cities Anti-War Committee, the Palestine Solidarity Group, the Columbia Action Network, Students for a Democratic Society, and the Freedom Road Socialist Organization. This undemocratic and suppressive action against antiwar and peace activists has been denounced and condemned by numerous antiwar and social justice organizations in the United States.
